



Attention Golfers! It is time to register for the first annual Push Push Pray Charity Golf Tournament! The “**Par-3**” tournament date is Sunday, June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024, and will be held at La Fortune Park Golf Course, Tulsa, OK. (4pm Shotgun Start)

The Par-3 (18 hole) golf course is Tulsa’s best Par-3 and features stadium lighting throughout the course and cart path. The lights will be on and will offer a unique way to enjoy the game of golf after dark.

### EVENT DETAILS:

**When:** Sunday, June 30<sup>th</sup>

**Where:** LaFortune Park Golf Course - 5501 S Yale Ave, Tulsa, OK 74135

**Registration:** Starts at 3:30 pm

**Start Time:** Shotgun start at 4:00 pm (Players need to be in or around their carts 15 min prior)

**Format:** two types of tournament play

**2-person “Tee-2-green” tournament**, where two golfers play as partners, with one player (either one) hitting their teams ball from tee to green. Once the ball is on the green, the other player putts out until the ball is in the hole. Grab your spouse for a date night, a friend who doesn’t take golf too seriously (and only like to putt), or someone you’d like to get to know better. Prize for the first place team, but 95% of the revenue will be going towards the foundation.

**2- person “Regular” scramble.** Both players will tee off then both will hit from the best position from there out until the ball is hit in the hole.

**Cost:**

\$155 per team (2-player team)

Fee Includes:

- Green Fee
- Practice Balls
- Golf Cart (one cart per team)

**Other cost options:**

- Mulligans: \$10 per shot (allows a “redo” on a shot)...limit two per player. Cannot be used on “hole-in-one contest.
- Putting contest: \$5 per putt, or \$15 for four putts.
